The following types of authorisations apply:


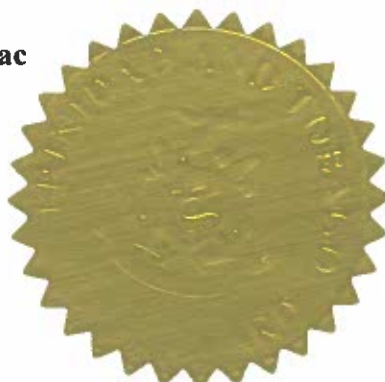
- a. The assessment of port facilities on behalf of the Designated Authority.
